- 1. USBC tournament rules will prevail. USBC entrants are not permitted to play game machines while bowling in the tournament. No food or beverages will be allowed in the bowling circle. House rules set forth by the host hotel and other participating hotels will be strictly enforced. Members of the USBC who conduct themselves in a manner deemed not within the standards expected of youth bowlers shall be disqualified from further participation in the tournament and reported to USBC for formal suspension from membership.
- 2. Entry in the State Tournament is open to Florida USBC Youth current sanctioned league members in good standing. Entries will be scheduled on a first come first serve basis. Local association entries will be scheduled after all other entries have been scheduled.
- 3. Handicap in all divisions will be 100% of 220.
- 4. PARTICIPATION Events will be Team (4 members), Doubles, Singles, and All Events. Team and Doubles can be any combination of boys and/or girls. Singles and All-events will have boys and girl's division. A bowler entering singles must bowl doubles. Bowlers entering doubles must bowl singles. Doubles event will be bowled first. All participants will bowl three (3) games in each event. All 3 events may be bowled in the same day. ALL BOWLERS' NAMES AND MONEY must accompany the entry form. ALL INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.
- 5. BOWLERS MAY BOWL MORE THAN ONCE IN ANY EVENT. FIRST TEAM/DOUBLES/SINGLES SCORE BOWLED WILL COUNT FOR ALL EVENTS, AND YOU MAY ONLY PLACE ONCE IN SINGLES. TEAMS MAY NOT HAVE MORE THAN TWO (2) ORIGINAL BOWLERS ON THE ADDITIONAL TEAM AND MUST HAVE A NEW DOUBLES PARTNER. Teams and doubles will bowl IN ORDER LISTED ON ENTRY FORM. BOWLERS MUST BOWL ON THEIR ORIGINAL ENTRY UNLESS THE ORIGINAL ENTRY IS WITHDRAWN FROM THE TOURNAMENT. Substitutes may be used and will bowl in the SAME LINE-UP POSITION. In Team and Doubles substitutions SUBSTITUTES AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED BY THE LOCAL ASSOCIATION MANAGER/MEMBERSHIP PROCESSOR AND SENT TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR NO LATER THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS AFTER SUBSITUTE HAS BOWLED, OTHERWISE ONLY SCRATCH SCORES WILL APPLY. ANY BOWLER ARRIVING AFTER THE SQUAD HAS STARTED WILL START BOWLING IN THE FRAME IN PROGRESS WHEN HE/SHE ARRIVED. NO SCORE WILL BE RECORDED FOR THE FRAMES MISSED. NO BLIND SCORES WILL BE USED. ONCE A SUBSTITUTE HAS BEEN PLACED AND STARTED TO BOWL FOR SCORE, HE/SHE WILL NOT BE REPLACED BY THE ORIGINAL BOWLER.
- 6. The entering average shall be the bowler's HIGHEST LEAGUE AVERAGE of TWELVE (12) GAMES OR MORE in any YOUTH sanctioned Florida league as of January 1, 2025. Bowlers NOT having an average as specified above will use HIGHEST AVERAGE OF TWELVE (12) GAMES OR MORE as of APRIL 15, 2025. Sport bowling average will be used only if they do not have a standard average and will be adjusted in accordance with the chart provided by USBC. FOR BOWLERS ONLY BOWLING SUMMER LEAGUE, THE 2024 SUMMER LEAGUE AVERAGE OF 12 GAMES OR MORE AS OF AUGUST 31, 2024 MAY BE USED. ALL AVERAGES MUST BE VERIFIED BY THE ASSOCIATION MANAGER/MEMBERSHIP PROCESSOR AND SUBMITTED TO THE TOURNAMENT MANAGER POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MAY 01, 2025. IF THE AVERAGE DEADLINES ARE NOT MET THE BOWLER MUST BOWL SCRATCH. IT IS THE LOCAL ASSOCIATION MANAGER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO REPORT THE AVERAGE TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR. Falsification of averages or any information will result in the disqualification of the bowler and/or team, with no refund of fees. BUMPER BOWLING AVERAGES CANNOT BE USED FOR THIS TOURNAMENT.
- 7. THE LOCAL ASSOCIATION MANAGER/MEMBERSHIP PROCESSOR is responsible for verification of averages and USBCY membership and MUST SIGN THE ENTRY FORM. THE COACH IS RESPONSIBLE for checking that all monies are correct and all, entries are properly executed before submitting entry to the state Tournament Director. IF ANY OF THE ABOVE IS NOT DONE THE ENTIRE ENTRY WILL BE REFUSED AND RETURNED.
- 8. No refund of entry fee will be made after entry has been processed, except where travel to the tournament site is prevented through the result of any declared natural disaster or emergency. In such event, an entrant shall be entitled to be rescheduled or a refund of bowling fees at the discretion of the tournament director.
- 9. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MAY 01, 2025.
- 10. ALL ENTRANTS MUST REPORT AT LEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE ASSIGNED TIME TO BOWL. SUBSTITIONS ARE TO BE MADE AT LEAST ONE (1) HOUR BEFORE TIME TO BOWL. NO SQUADS WILL BE DELAYED FOR SUBSTITUTIONS OR LATE ARRIVALS.

- 11. SCHOLARSHIPS to be given on the ratio of one (1) for each eight (8) entries in handicap divisions. In case of a tie for first place, co- champions will be declared. Scholarship money is combined and divided equally. Scholarships will be given to FIRST, AND SECOND PLACE WINNERS in All Events Handicap in all Divisions. Scratch Events paid out based on number of entries received.
- 12. An appeal or protest regarding scores or eligibility must be made in writing to the tournament manager within seventy-two (72) hours after the error or infraction has occurred.
- 13. PROPER ATTIRE & EQUIPMENT IS REQUIRED. NO HALTERS, TANK TOPS OR HEAD APPAREL WILL BE ALLOWED. Shorts, skorts or skirts must be longer than your fingertips when placed by your side. All pants will be worn at waist level with no underwear or bare skin showing. Tournament officials will determine proper attire. Youth Participants will not wear or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competitions (rule 301b). THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR WILL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ASK ANY BOWLER TO CHANGE THEIR CLOTHING OR EQUIPMENT. IF THE BOWLER REFUSES, HE OR SHE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BOWL AND THE ENTRY FEE WILL BE FORFEITED.
- 14. TEAM NAMES MUST BE COMPLETE NAMES. NO INITIALS OR ABBREVIATIONS ARE ALLOWED. THE TOURNAMENT MANAGER WILL CHANGE ANY TEAM NAME DEEMED UNSUITABLE WITH USBC YOUTH STANDARDS.
- 15. ONLY bowlers, scorekeepers and tournament personnel will be allowed in bowling circle.
- 16. NO UNNECESSARY DELAY WILL BE ALLOWED. Any bowler not present and ready to bowl in turn without permission of a tournament official will be given a zero (0) for the frames missed.
- 17. One bowling ball per bowler on the ball return. Failure to remove the extra bowling balls will result in disqualification. No substance of any kind may be placed on score table or ball returns. Dry towels and pads only may be placed on the score console or ball return. Altering the surface of a bowling ball by use of abrasives, cleaners and/or polishes is prohibited during competition, including warm up prior to your squad. No substance may be placed on the outer surface of the bowling ball. No modifications can be made to affect the balance of the ball once competition has begun.
- 18. If equipment failure on a pair of lanes would delay the progress of the game/series, tournament officials can authorize the completion of a game/series on another pair of certified lanes. The interrupted game/series must be resumed from the point of interruption. (Rule #321) There will be no practice before resuming the game.
